


EYFS Early Years Foundation Stage Profile: End of Reception)

Children are assessed as achieving a 'Good level of Develoipment' (GLD) if they achieve their ELG (Early Learning Goal) in the Prime Areas (Physical Development, Communication & Language and Personal, Social & Emotional Development) and in the Specific Areas of Literacy (reading & writing) and maths. 
Year I Phonics Screening Check

Year 2 Phonics Resit Check


Any Year 2 children who did not pass the screening check in Year I are retested at the end of Year 2. This graph shows the % of children who passed the resit at the end of Year 2.




KSI: Key Stage I (End of Year 2) SATs Results

Children sit statutory tests, which are marked internally. The results of these tests are used alongside children's day to day work in school and other school assessment information to reach a teacher assessment judgement for reading, writing & maths, against national criteria. Children working at 'age-related expectation' are assessed as reaching the 'expected standard;' children working at a higher level are assessed as reaching 'greater depth.'




KSI Writing Expected Standard+



KSI Reading Greater Depth











KS2: Key Stage 2 (End of Year 6) SATs Results

Children sit statutory tests, which are sent off for external marking, in reading, maths and grammar, punctuation & spelling. Children's writing is assessed by teacher assessment against a set of national criteria and is moderated within school, with other local schools and every 4 years by the local authority.


KS2 Reading Expected Standard+

KS2 Reading Greater Depth







KS2 Writing Expected Standard+




KS2 Maths Expected Standard+
