Dear Parents,

Singing Lessons and Choir at Long Sutton Primary School.

My name is Anne, and I am a local singing teacher and choir conductor. I am delighted to have been asked by the school to take over the running of the choir, and to offer singing lessons. The plan is for singing lessons to take place during school time on Friday afternoons, with choir continuing to be after school on a Friday.

I have worked in several schools teaching individually and leading choirs. My students have scored highly in singing exams, taken part in festivals and school musicals, or even gone on to study at Drama School. I specialise in teaching music through specially chosen singing games and activities, which as well as being a wonderful way to learn, has been shown to help with language and maths skills.

The cost of the after school choir club will be £5 per student per week, payable termly, and the emphasis will be on enjoyment as well as high standards. Choir will run from 3.15 to 4.15pm.

Singing lessons are 20 minutes long, and can be taken as individual lessons, pairs or small groups, and will cost between £40 and £120 per term, depending on the size of the group. I believe that everyone can learn to sing, regardless of perceived ability or talent, and these lessons will help students to:

- Develop a beautiful, healthy singing voice
- Keep a beat and clap a rhythm
- Sing in tune
- Enjoy singing and music making with others
- Learn music reading and listening skills
- Improve confidence and concentration
- Do all of the above while having great fun and playing games

For older children, there will be more focus on singing technique and performance skills.

The most important thing to me is that your child is having great quality training in a highly enjoyable environment. Please contact me if you would like more information, or you wish to sign up. I am happy to arrange some taster sessions in school time so your child can experience the fun of lessons before making a commitment.
