

What happens when my child is added to the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) register?

Your child will be added to the School's confidential SEND

register under one or more of these areas of need:

Cognition and Learning

Communication and Interaction

Social, Emotional and Mental Health

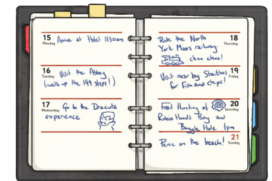
Sensory and/or Physical needs

Your child's class teachers will create a Personalised Learning Plan (PLP), this will have input from your child, you and other adults who work with them.

Support



Your child will have additional support from the adults in school. The PLP will also mention things that you can help with at home. With your agreement, we might also request help from other professionals.

We will review your child's PLP at October half term, February half term and May half term. We will ask to meet with you to get your feedback. If things are going well, your child might come off the SEND register. If we feel that the PLP is not making enough of a difference, the next step would be to apply for an Education Health Care Plan.
