LOVE

Love is a core value for our church school because God the Father so loved the world that he sent his son, Jesus, to show us how to care for each other.

COURAGE

Courage is a core value for our church school because Jesus teaches us to do the right thing and make the right choices, even when this is hard to do.

In **Joshua 1 verse 9**, God told Joshua to, 'Be strong and courageous; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.' Jesus showed us the importance of making the right choices through the story of the wise and foolish builders. He showed courage by standing up for what is right and giving his life for us.

We show courage by standing up for what is right and **respecting** each other's differences; persevering when things are difficult and encouraging others to do the same. We try to be wise in our choices, even when the right choice is the hard choice.
